- ▶ Add two 4-digit numbers - no exchange
- ▶ Add two 3-digit numbers - crossing 10 or 100 R
- ▶ Add two 4-digit numbers - one exchange
- ▶ Add two 4-digit numbers - more than one exchange
- ▶ Subtract a 3-digit number from a 3-digit number - no exchange R
- ▶ Subtract two 4-digit numbers - no exchange
- ▶ Subtract a 3-digit number from a 3-digit number - exchange R
- ▶ Subtract two 4-digit numbers - one exchange
- ▶ Subtract two 4-digit numbers - more than one exchange
- ▶ Efficient subtraction
- ▶ Estimate answers
- ▶ Checking strategies
