Phonics screening test

Through the year children will have daily Phonics lessons which helps them to read and write.

Every child across the country in Year 1 will take a statutory phonics screening test, where children read real words and nonsense words. There are 40 words for children to read and they will use their phonics skills which they have learnt throughout the year. For many years the pass mark has been 32.

Due to Covid these statutory tests have been cancelled for 2 years running however it has been confirmed these tests will go ahead next June.

To help your child prepare for the statutory tests, reading at home is encouraged daily to give children the best chance.



Reading

All children will have:

- a staged reading book
- a reading for pleasure book which they can choose to change at any point.
- a Reading Record

A book bag will need to be in school each day Reading books are selected based on their fluency skills

We aim that each child will share a reading experience every day at home and at school

We ask that their reading record is signed:

- at least twice a week, by an adult at home
- once a week, by an adult in school
